



Volunteer Roles

Check here for a description of what the various volunteer positions at Brave the Bay mean and do.

Bag Check – 7:45am-12:30pm – As people go out on the run, or prepare to plunge in the bay, they need a place to put their things. Volunteers help check the bags and keep an eye on the bags.

Breakdown – 11:30am-1:30pm – Come at the end, to help us pack up and head home.

Course Monitors – 7:45am-11:30am – Course Monitors stand along the race course at all the turns, to help cheer on the walkers/runners, and make sure people don't get lost.

Course Walker – 8:30am-11:30am – The Course Walker walks at the very end of the 5k walk, with the slowest or latest walkers. This person's job is to let the Course Monitors know when their job is done.

Food Table – 7:30am-10:30am – Help serve food! We'll be handing out snacks for the participants.

Incentives – 7:15-11:30am – People can earn various incentives for fundraising – t-shirts, blankets, etc. At the incentives table, volunteers help get the participants their swag.

Make-A-Wish Table – 8am-1pm – Help give out info about Make-A-Wish and tell the Make-A-Wish story. This position is best for people who are already involved in Make-A-Wish, whether as wish granters or wish families.

Activities Tents – 8am-12:30pm – We are going to have some fun activities to keep people entertained. Help run those activities!

Raffle – 8:30am-1pm – Help raise money by selling raffle tickets. This position requires walking up to strangers to make a sale – best for outgoing, sales(wo)manlike volunteers!

Setup – 6am-8am – Come early to help get the tents, finish line, and signage set up before the guests start arriving.

Timers – 10:30am – 1:30pm - the cable car pull competition is a timed race, so we need a couple volunteers armed with stopwatches to time the race.
